COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE REGULATION B
EXEMPTION OF CENTURY PETROLEUM CORPORATION
AND DALLAS OIL & GAS, INC.

LIBRARY

The Commission has issued an order temporarily suspending the Regulation B exemption from registration under the Securities Act of 1933 with regard to the public offering of fractional undivided interests in oil and gas leases in the Century Petroleum Corporation offerings. (Rel. 33-5636)

The Commission has also issued an order temporarily suspending the Regulation B exemption from registration under the Securities Act of 1933 with regard to the public offering of fractional undivided interests in oil and gas leases in the Dallas Oil & Gas, Inc. offerings. (Rel. 33-5637)

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

JOE T. BOYD, OTHERS CONVICTED

The Fort Worth and New York Regional Offices and the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York announced that on October 20 following a three-criminal trial in New York City, Joe T. Boyd and Dr. M.S. Knisely, both of Midland, Texas, Robert E. Ford and Ernest D. Goodloe, both of Abilene, Texas, and Ernest R. Mullenax, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, were convicted of violations of the securities registration and anti-fraud provisions of the securities laws and the fraud by wire and mail fraud statutes, and conspiracy to violate those laws. In addition, Boyd, Goodloe, Ford and Knisely were convicted of furnishing written false statements to the Securities and Exchange Commission.

The jury acquitted Emerson F. Titlow and Roger Bissett, both of Reno, Nevada, William Wayne Barnett, Abilene, Texas, and Marvin J. Rappaport, Stanley Schleger and Edward Vanasco all of New York City, on all counts.

Prior to the start of the trial, Howard Brookshire, Atoka, Oklahoma, and during the trial, Selwyn S. Weber, Odessa, Texas, were severed as defendants and are to be tried later.

In addition, James C. Joiner, Lubbock, Texas, and John Wells, New York City, had previously entered pleas of guilty to one count of conspiracy to violate the securities laws, and the fraud by wire, mail fraud, and false statements statutes. Previously, Alan Segal, New York City, had plead guilty to four counts of conspiracy, fraud by wire, mail fraud, securities registration and securities fraud.

Federal District Judge Milton Pollack, New York City, set sentencing for Boyd, Goodloe, Ford, Mullenax and Knisely for December 2. Judge Pollack set sentencing for Joiner, Wells, and Segal for December 5. (U.S. v. Joe T. Boyd, et al., S.D.N.Y.). (LR-7134)

TWO MINING PROMOTERS ENJOINED

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on October 16 the Honorable Russell E. Smith, Chief Judge of the U.S. District Court of Montana at Missoula, preliminarily enjoined Francis D. Duval and Vance D. McCarty of Spokane, Washington from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Preliminary relief was not granted as to two defendants, Estelle H. Duval a Spokane transfer agent and Wayne L. Sanders a salesman alleged to have participated in violations of Section 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933. (SEC v. Francis D. Duval, et al., D. Mont., C.A. No. 75-35 GF). (LR-7135)

The Washington Regional Office announced that on October 21 before the federal court in Washington, D.C., Thomas F. Clendenin of Silver Spring, Maryland was sentenced to imprisonment for a term of one year and one day. Clendenin previously pleaded guilty to 3 counts of a 59 count criminal indictment. One count charged Clendenin with mail fraud in the offer and sale of unregistered securities, 1 count charged interstate transportation of stolen securities and 1 count charged him with acting as an unregistered investment adviser. (U.S. v. Thomas F. Clendenin, U.S.D.C., D.C., Criminal No. 75-543). (LR-7136)
