The subject matter of the May 25 open meeting will be:

The Commission will meet with the Public Oversight Board (POB) of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants to discuss oversight of accounting firms which practice before the Commission. The POB is an independent board of prominent individuals established by the AICPA to oversee the activities of the SEC Practice Section of the AICPA's Division for CPA Firms and to represent the public interest in the performance of its oversight function. Topics of discussion are expected to include POB and Commission oversight of the peer review and special investigations processes and developments in the profession's quality control program since the last joint meeting in July 1986. (1) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment amendments to Forms N-3 and N-4, the registration forms for insurance company separate accounts issuing variable annuities, under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Act of 1933 and published related staff guidelines for the forms. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

CORRECTION RE IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

In the May 18th News Digest under "Self-Regulatory Organizations," the release number for the rule change filed by the National Securities Clearing Corporation that became effective in accordance with Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 was erroneously stated. The correct release number is 34-25699, not 34-24699.

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-88-11) relating to the permanent deletion of restrictions on specified underwriting activities of approved persons of specialist member organizations entitled to exemptive relief under Rule 98. The Commission granted accelerated approval to that portion of the proposed rule change which requested extension of the effectiveness of the temporary deletion of the managing underwriter restriction until such time as the Commission makes a decision regarding permanent approval of this proposal. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-10) to extend to December 16, 1988 the stock options pilot program providing for four expiration months, including two near-term months, instead of quarterly expiration cycles. (Rel. 34-25702)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-88-11) to add certain new rules relating to the trading of "European" style options on U.S. Treasury notes and bonds. In addition, the Amex is proposing to implement a new electronic limit order system for the trading of these new options. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 23. (Rel. 34-25703)

AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed Amendment No. 1 to proposed rule change SR-NASD-88-1. The amendment defines the term "maximum order size," provides guidelines for establishing maximum order size levels in SOES, and defines the term "minimum exposure limit" as it pertains to maximum order size. The amendment requires that SOES order entry firms and SOES market makers enter and execute, respectively, individual orders in sizes equal to or smaller than maximum order size in any security traded through SOES. It further requires SOES market makers to execute orders in amounts equal to the greater of their exposure limit or the minimum exposure limit, in any NASDAQ/NMS security. (Rel. 34-25704)
