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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### STAFF ACCOUNTING BULLETIN ON PRINCIPAL STOCKHOLDER TRANSACTIONS

The staff has released Staff Accounting Bulletin (SAB) No. 79, which expresses the staff's views regarding the accounting for transactions undertaken by a company's principal stockholder for the benefit of the company. The SAB states that, when a principal stockholder pays an expense for the company, the company should reflect the expense and a corresponding capital contribution in its financial statements.

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### COMPLAINT NAMES MOHD A. ASLAMI

The Boston Regional Office filed a Complaint on August 18 in the Western Section of the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts alleging insider trading and reporting violations by Mohd A. Aslami, a former executive vice president of SpecTran Corporation. The Complaint alleges that Aslami sold 20,000 shares of SpecTran's stock just prior to news announcements by SpecTran that it would suffer substantial losses in revenue for that quarter. Aslami, in a Stipulation and Consent filed along with the Complaint, agreed to pay \$117,080 which represents the loss that he avoided by selling the stock before the bad news announcements and a penalty for selling the stock. Aslami consented to a permanent injunction against him without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations. (SEC v. Mohd A. Aslami, No. 88-0096-XX, DMA). (LR-11852)

## MILTON R. BLOOMQUIST ENJOINED

The Salt Lake City Branch Office announced that on August 23 Milton R. Bloomquist of Layton, Utah consented, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, to a permanent injunction against violating the securities registration, the investment company registration, and the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The disgorgement issue is reserved pending testimony by Bloomquist.

The March 9 Complaint alleged that from 1981 through 1987, Bloomquist offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of promissory notes to over 100 investors. Bloomquist was said to have obtained in excess of \$3.6 million for the purpose of pooling investor funds to purchase securities. He was alleged to have misrepresented the success of his program and the source of funds used to pay the promised 2% or 3% interest per month. Allegedly, he made no trading profits and instead paid "interest" from new loan proceeds. The Complaint also asserted that Bloomquist engaged in unauthorized activities as an unregistered investment company. (SEC v. Milton R. Bloomquist, USDC DUT, Northern Division, Civil Action No. 88-NC-26J). (LR-11853)

## ROBERT SLATTERY PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Commission today announced the filing of an injunctive action against Robert Slattery, a Divisional Vice President of Reebok International, Ltd. The Complaint alleged that Slattery violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder in connection with the trading in the securities of Reebok and Avia Group International, Inc.

The Commission's Complaint alleged that Slattery misappropriated material nonpublic information concerning Reebok's acquisition of Avia by selling 1,000 shares of Avia common stock on March 9, 1987. The Complaint alleged that the market price of Avia common stock declined from \$27-1/2 to \$16-1/2 following the announcement. Slattery sold shares of Avia common stock on March 9, avoiding losses of \$9,209.36 and realized a profit of \$1,920.17 on the purchase of Reebok call options.

In settlement of the Commission action, Slattery consented, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, to the entry of a permanent injunction, to disgorge the sum of \$11,129.53, and to pay a penalty of \$11,129.53 under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L), subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to amend and restate the Agreement of Consolidation or Merger constituting its articles of incorporation (Charter) with the proposed Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation. In addition, AP&L proposes to create a new class of preferred stock with a par value of \$.01 per share (Class A Preferred), which will be pari passu with AP&L's outstanding \$100 preferred stock and \$25 preferred stock. In conjunction with the creation of the Class A Preferred, the total number of authorized shares will be increased by 15 million shares. [An order authorizing the solicitation of proxies for the Special Meeting of Shareholders on October 19 was issued on August 5.] (Rel. 35-24707 - Aug. 31)

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes filed by the following have become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934: The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-88-3) which is an interpretation of Rules G-12 and G-15 concerning the confirmation, delivery and reclamation of transactions in municipal securities that are issuable both in registered and bearer form (interchangeable securities). (Rel. 34-26044); and The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-37) which makes a technical systems change to the Small Order Execution System (SOES) and includes interpretations of the SOES Rules to provide clarifications concerning the aggregation of orders and the entry of orders by professional traders for their own accounts. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
