## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### COMMISSION HOLDS TWO-DAY OPEN FORUM

On behalf of the Securities and Exchange Commission, Chairman Richard C. Breeden has announced that the Commission will conduct a two-day public forum on "Corporate Governance and American Economic Competitiveness: The Role of Shareholders, Directors and Management." The Conference will be held at the Willard Hotel in Washington, D.C., on Thursday, March 19, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., and Friday, March 20, 1992, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The registration fee is \$35.00 per person, and may be paid at the door. Further details can be obtained from Melissa Kimps, (202) 272-2801.

The central issue to be addressed by Forum speakers is whether this country's corporate governance system provides a sound foundation for meeting the competitive challenges of the global marketplace that confront U.S. business over the next decade and into the 21st Century. Panel discussions will focus initially on such overarching issues as the role of corporate governance in enhancing economic performance of American companies, factors influencing the time horizons of U.S. businesses versus those of their foreign competitors, and the impact of U.S. corporate investment horizons on long-term competitiveness. There will follow panel discussions covering, respectively, the role of corporate management, boards of directors, shareholders in today's governance system, and the implications of increasing institutional shareownership.

Speakers at the Forum will include leading scholars, business executives, shareholders and government officials. Among the confirmed speakers are the Hon. Carl Levin, U.S. Senator, Dr. C. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
